

FISHING RULES

PERMIT METHODS & RESTRICTIONS

All tickets/permits are date specific, non-refundable or non-transferable

All tickets/permits are subject to our angling rules and by purchasing a permit you commit and agree to abide by the rules and policies set out below. All rules are there to protect the safety and wellbeing of anglers and livestock.

DAY TICKETS

- Fishing is not permitted before 7:30am or after dark (no night fishing allowed)
- Up to 2 rods per person
- Tickets/permits are charged at a cost of £10 per person per day.
- Under 13's are free with a paying adult
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

SITE ACCESS

- Do not park on the grass
- The Maximum speed limit at Bowland Lakes Leisure Village is 10MPH
- Do not obstruct access to fishing pegs
- For the Serpentine & Butterfly Lakes, unload fishing equipment and then move your vehicle to designated parking bays (unless permission is granted by Park Manager)

FISHERY RULES

- A valid licence must be produced upon request by staff
- All nets must be dipped on entry and before you fish on every visit NO EXCEPTIONS
- No tiger nuts, cat food, or dog food allowed
- No barbed hooks allowed
- No keep nets allowed
- No spinning allowed
- Unhooking mats & landing nets must be used for ALL fish
- All ledger rigs are to be either free running or breakout leads
- No wading or entering of the water
- Take all litter home or use the bins provided



Terms and conditions

Day tickets/permits are available on the banks at Bowland Lakes Leisure Village for general coarse fishing. Payment can be made at reception (in the office lodge), or if no one is available you may set-up and we will collect payment and issue a ticket on the bank. Please keep your ticket with you along with a form of photographic identification and an appropriate EA rod licence.

We accept both card and cash payments.

It is a condition or purchase that you accept and agree to spot checks of your Permit(s) EA licence, identification, tackle, equipment, bags and catch at any time; at any time, if a member of the Boland Lakes Leisure Village staff believes you to be breaching any of these rules, contravening their permit terms, or behaving in a disruptive manner, then it is our right to ask you to return any fish in your possession, and to leave the site immediately and without compensation.

Bowland Lakes Leisure Village reserve the right to exclude anglers at any time from the whole, or any specific part of Bowland Lakes Leisure Village.

Anglers park their car at their own risk and are requested to park sensibly, please refer to the fishing rules for driving/parking rules.

Please ensure that you help us to prevent the spread of disease to our fish. All footwear and fishing equipment must have been thoroughly cleaned and dried before entering our site. Once you have arrived, please use the dips to disinfect your equipment before you start fishing and before leaving site.

Anglers must respect, follow and observe the country code. This means no litter to be left, no dogs running loose on site, no loud music, and no fires. Barbeques are allowed but must be kept off the ground and used in the designated area. These must be cooled and watered down before disposing.
